

PROVISIONS OF THE COOKIES PRIVACY POLICY

- 1.1. A cookie is a small text document with a unique identification number which is transmitted from a website to your computer to distinguish between personal computer, browser type, and person's activity on the Internet. A unique number identifies your browser each time you visit the Website. Cookies prevent from remembering personal information (such as person's name and address). Websites use cookies to track statistics such as the number of visits and traffic on the Website. Such information is not linked to personal information. You may disable the use of cookies at any time, but without the cookies some features of the Website may not function or may function improperly.
- 1.2. Cookies help the Controller identify you as a previous visitor of the Website, save your visit history and customise the content accordingly. This is how the Controller can improve the Website and make it more convenient for you.
- 1.3. Objectives of cookie use:
 - 1.3.1. carrying out main activity of the Website and ensuring operation thereof;
 - 1.3.2. providing relevant information and offers;
 - 1.3.3. collecting statistical data.
- 1.4. Cookies used on the Website:

Cookie name	Validity period	Data processing purpose
_utma	2 years	Stores information about how many times you have visited the website, from your first visit to your last visit.
_utmb	30 minutes	Stores timestamp, exact time when you accessed the Website.
_utmc	Until the end of the session	Stores timestamp, exact time when you left the Website. After 30 minutes, if you have not left the Website, the cookie automatically expires.
_utmz	6 months	Stores information from where you came to the Website, what search engine you used, which link you clicked on, which keywords were used, and from where in the world you accessed the Website.
_ga	2 years	Stores information about the purpose of your visit, which enables preparing reports on the activity of the Website for website operators and

		improving your experience of visiting the Website.
_gat	During browsing session	Stored information enables limiting the frequency of inquiries.
_gid	24 hours	Stored information enables distinguishing between people accessing the Website.

- 1.5. You can allow cookies to be saved or opt out. Most web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can change your browser settings to refuse cookies or to receive a warning message before saving them. Read your browser instructions or just learn more about these functions. You can learn more about cookies and how to manage them on this website at <https://www.aboutcookies.org/>. To delete all cookies stored on your computer, read the instructions provided by your browser manufacturer, which can be found by clicking “Help” in the browser menu. Remember that if you choose not to accept cookies, you may not be able to use the interactive features of this Website.
